The Pope is On a Roll

Recent weeks have seen a number of new maneuvers by Pope Francis pushing the causes of a world religion and world government.

On the religious front, the pope and Anglican Archbishop Justin Welby recently met in Rome to pledge their "undeterred" efforts to "see their two churches" formally reunited. Declaring agreement on baptism, communion, and use of the Bible, they admitted remaining differences on the role of women in ministry and views on sexuality. Should the Vatican succeed in absorbing

Canadian Doctor Loses Fight for Children's Innocence

An Ontario, Canada, father has just been told that his only recourse is to remove his children from the public schools if he wishes to protect them from homosexual indoctrination. The case is being closely followed because of its importance in the struggle between parental rights and the new civil (sexual) rights laws.

Dentist Steve Tourloukis requested that he be notified whenever his kindergartener and second grader was to be exposed to lesson material, such as abortion and homosexuality, that conflicted with his Greek Orthodox faith. When the school board refused, he asked the Ontario Superior Court to uphold his parental rights to freedom of religion and declare that he was the final authority over the education of his children.

How to Test a New Bible —Before You Buy

When the bookstore clerk hands you a new Bible to purchase what should you look for? Normally we just assume the text is okay and focus on the helps, price or binding. Does it have a concordance? Does it have center references? Is it highlighted for specific study courses? Is it designed for a specific purpose such as a kid's, teen's, soul winner's, or study Bible? Is it in my price range?

Today, that's not enough. Just because it is the same Bible as what my pastor uses, it matches my Sunday school lessons, or it's recommended by my denomination, doesn't make it a safe book to really know what God said.

Modern technology has given us a much deeper look into the history of the Bible texts behind that Bible handed to you over the bookstore counter. It's not enough to just "trust the scholars" and take the Bible home if the price is right.

Here is what else you should ask before you purchase:

- 1.) Is Acts 8: 37 missing? (This is a handy verse to show a Roman Catholic that infant baptism won't work.)
- 2.) Is there a footnote suggesting that Mark 16:9-20 is not in the "oldest and best" manuscripts? (Then how can I know if Jesus really rose from the dead?)
- 3.) Does 1 Cor. 1:18 tell you that you are just "being saved" or safely saved?
- 4.) Does it have some strange books like Tobit, Maccabees, Esdras, Shepherd of Hermas, etc?
- 5.) Does John 3:16 show that Jesus was just an "only Son" or the only "begotten" Son? (If "begotten" is not there, how was Jesus different from the "sons of God" in John 1:12?)
- 6.) Is Jesus in Acts 3:26 a servant instead of a Son?
- 7.) Is the path beyond the narrow gate in Matt 7:14 a difficult path instead of just a narrow one?
 - 8.) Does 1 John 5:7 omit the Trinity? If yes is the answer to any of these questions,

that Bible has a questionable history. Creators of that translation have used source documents (manuscripts) that contain contradictions and omissions.

Sometimes we act like Matthew and John just wrote out the Bible in English. Fact is, there is a lot of history in the 2000 years since Jesus walked in Galilee. Several languages are involved over the centuries.

When we buy a used car, we want to know the history. If the original owner was a "little old lady from Pasadena," we trust the quality more than if it was owned by a hotrod enthusiast. Why should we not also be interested in the history of our Bible?

Researcher David W. Daniels has spent several years using current investigative tools to dig out new information about the history of our Bibles. One finding is that there are two streams of manuscripts in Bible history. And they are hugely different.

One has two thousand years of a steady, traceable series of copies of the Bible in well-known, historical languages. The other comes from the hands of questionable characters with no verifiable history before 1800.

Daniels published a book, <u>Look What's</u> <u>Missing</u>, in 2013 listing over 240 missing words and verses in the modern Bibles. Another Daniels book, <u>Did the Catholic Church Give us the Bible?</u>, lists hundreds of problems with the two streams of Bible history.

Anyone who does not perform "due diligence" before buying the next Bible risks reading a book that shifts meanings away from God's true word.

Any pastor or teacher who does not research this issue also risks guiding people to a defective book gutted of the true power of God's word.

Other resources by Daniels include dozens of YouTube videos and other books called *Why They Changed the Bible*, (2014) and *Did Jesus Use the Septuagint* (2017), explaining the details of this danger.

Which Bible Really Gets Read?

A couple of years ago a group from Indiana University-Perdue set out to research actual Bible reading in the U.S. What they found goes against the accepted view that the modern Bibles have taken over the Bible reading world.

First of all they found that "...nearly eight in ten Americans regard the Bible as either the literal word of God or as inspired by God." However, they discovered that American Christians have a "complex relationship to their scripture," with "surprising gaps in Americans' biblical literacy."

Pastors have long been frustrated by

parishioners who claim to revere the Bible but are "slow to read it for themselves."

The study found that only 50% of Americans read any kind of scripture in the past year. And of those who did read, 95% listed the Bible as their choice. The rest claimed to read other "scriptures" such as the Qur'an, Torah or other religious material. Of the half who read no scripture, two-thirds of them still claimed to view the Bible in very high regard.

In the last 25 years, much has been made about the New International Version (NIV) overtaking the King James Version (KJV)

Does the Apocrypha Belong in Your Bible?

I've been getting letters and email from people about their pastor, who starts to quote from Ecclesiasticus —it sounds like Ecclesiastes, but it's not. Or who reads from the Wisdom of Solomon —not to be confused with the Proverbs of Solomon. Or who talks about the "moral lessons" to be learned from "Deuterocanonical" books like Tobit or Judith.

Other teachers or preachers talk about how their denomination started with people reading a Bible "complete with the Apocrypha" —as if without it, the Bible is incomplete. Or they say, "The original King James Bible had the Apocrypha. So people who trust the King James shouldn't have a Bible without it."

What is wrong with this picture? And why is it happening now, 400 years after the King James was first printed? Did the Christians trust the Apocrypha way back then? And what is the "Apocrypha," or "Deuterocanonical books," anyway?

The Apocrypha is a collection of fables, not books of faith. Not a *bit* of it is inspired, or even claims to be. So why should it be in a Bible? Our Old Testament is the Hebrews' scripture. They didn't include Apocrypha in their Hebrew scripture. So if they didn't

trust it as scripture, why should we?


But they counter, "Jesus and the Apostles used the Septuagint, and the Septuagint had the Apocrypha. So we must use the Apocrypha." That sounds convincing.

But this claim is bogus. A search of all sources, using modern technology, finds no evidence of the Septuagint being the Bible of the Apostles. It first appeared in the years after Christ died. It has only survived to this day because the fables of the Apocrypha support some of the unbiblical dogmas of Roman Catholicism.

Included in that plot was an attempt to insert these fictional tales into the King James Bible. King James put Richard Bancroft in charge of the translators. He was Archbishop of Canterbury, head of the Church of England. He almost corrupted the KJV by forcing the translators to include the Apocrypha. He succeeded in getting the Apocrypha between the covers, but the translators refused to include it in either Testament. They stuck it in a separate section, labeled each page "Apocrypha" and gave 7 objections to including it.

When printers began producing the KJV, the people demanded copies without the

as Bible best seller. But do they read it? The study says, not as much as the KJV! Of the people who regularly read the Bible, the KJV was preferred 55% of the time. Only 19%

used the NIV. The next four in popularity come in with only single digits.

When the study looked at the Bible used during congregational worship, 40% reported preferring the

KJV. Ten percent of the others used the New Revised Standard Version (NRSV). Other versions were less than 10% each.

The authors of the study said that, although the possible reasons for KJV preference was outside the scope of their research, they mentioned the belief by the "King James Only movement" that it was the "literal words of God."

Author David W. Daniels says, "Guilty as charged!" If you believe the Bible at all, you have to deal with the several places where God says He will preserve His words. (See Ps. 12:6-7; 119:140, 160; Prov. 30:5, etc.) Jesus assured the disciples that heaven and earth may pass away, but His words would not (Matt. 5:18; 24:35; Mark 13:31; Luke 21:33). "So, if that is true, where are they?" asks Daniels.

He points out that all the other versions have "doubting notes" laced in the text, raising questions about whether certain

Apocrypha. But the plotters did not stop. All Roman Catholic Bibles since then have included it. Today you are hearing more about it because of the crusade to make a common Bible that all "denominations" can use.

And beyond that is the emerging world religion that is calling for a gutted Bible that will mesh with the other religious literature of the world, a one-world Bible for the one-world religion. Essential to the verses belong in the Bible. In some cases, whole verses or words that appear in the KJV, are omitted in the others.

The researchers in this study expressed

surprise that "...the King James Version is the top choice —by a wide margin— of Bible readers." Daniels points out that it's a matter of trust. The KJV has a 400-year history of

sparking powerful revivals in Western countries. And when it was translated into other languages on the mission fields, the same message was clearly understood by the humblest of peoples and hearts were renewed by the Spirit of God.

The researchers speculated that the appeal of the classic language of the KJV might be a factor in its popularity. Daniels says that they are close. The classic English is far more precise in conveying God's exact words than modern Bibles that attempt to adapt to the ever-changing nuances of today's English.

It makes a lot of sense that the Creator of the precisely designed universe would inspire one precise Bible in English for us to simply learn and obey. It is obvious that man's attempt to "update" it has only led to confusion.

one-world Bible is the Greek Septuagint containing the Apocrypha, so that Rome's pagan doctrines such as wafer worship, Virgin Mary goddess, and salvation by works are supported.

religious rights must be subject to the government's rules of "inclusivity, equality and multiculturalism. Since homosexual behavior has been legalized, activists demand to be equally included in our culture. They will not tolerate any reference to it being sinful.

Representatives from a teacher's union argued in the case that the law required that

"inclusivity" (homosexual propaganda) be laced into all aspects of the curriculum and that it was impractical to notify the parents every time it occurred.



Another aspect of the court's decision was assignment of attorney's fees. Because the verdict was against Dr. Tourloukis, he is now responsible for both his own fees and those of the school board because they won the case. The total for the four-year trial runs near a million dollars.

This factor alone discourages most people from taking on such a fight. Tourloukis is considering whether to appeal the verdict, but if he does, the cost will continue to escalate.

Canada is on the forefront of where the U.S. is headed. Last year, when the U.S. Supreme court invented the right to same-sex

marriage in the Constitution, this loosened the attack dogs on anyone who disagrees with the full approval of this "abomination."

Previous BATTLE CRY articles have documented how homosexual indoctrination is already far advanced in the U.S. schools. It is part of the "sexual revolution" that began over 50 years ago.

How Old is the Moon?

Recent pictures of the moon's surface have evolutionists scrambling for an explanation. High-resolution images by a lunar orbiter since 2009 show over 200 new craters on the surface. "Not only does this study invalidate the idea that craters only form over long eras, but the research suggests that these regular impacts could completely alter the surface of the moon within a timescale of thousands—not millions—of years," wrote Garrett Haley on *Christiannews.net*.



Tom and Krinny Gaudet have a wide-ranging ministry from Bulgaria to Thailand. They funnel hundreds of thousands of Chick tracts through the local churches and outreaches. 



the Anglicans and Episcopalians, some 85 million new members would be added to the pope's idolatry.

An article in the last issue of BATTLE CRY detailed the meeting between the pope and the Lutheran World Federation on the 500th

anniversary of the beginning of the Reformation. During his trip to the year-long celebration in



October he suggested six new "Beatitudes" to deal with today's problems.

One conferred a blessing on "those who helped protect and care for our common home." This continued his signature theme of environmentalism, the subject of a recent encyclical. The pope has chosen to push the climate change hoax as a common enemy that all religions and political ideologies can relate to.

Another addressed immigration with a plea for mercy for the "abandoned and marginalized." Here he was building support for the developed nations to open their arms to the floods of refugees from the turmoil in other nations. Doing so will overwhelm their resources bringing the economic and social chaos necessary for the rise of the antichrist.

Still another highlighted "those who pray and work for full communion between Christians." Many evangelicals and other Protestants have fallen for the pope's enticements to unity. While Catholicism has steadfastly refused to give an inch on its core beliefs in a wafer god, Virgin Mary goddess, and salvation by works, Protestants have abandoned biblical truth for the siren song of love and unity at any cost.

Other "new beatitudes" dealt with forgiveness for persecution, seeing "God in every person," and sacrifice for others.

Information also surfaced recently about Francis's involvement in the United Religions Initiative (URI) while he was

Cardinal Jorge Bergoglio in Argentina. URI is a movement started by a San Francisco Episcopal Bishop, William Swing. URI promotes interfaith dialog and cooperation with the goal of persuading all religions to live in harmony for the good of all. Financial supporters include George Soros and Bill Gates.

The pope's involvement fits neatly with his other efforts for world political and religious unity. URI boasts of 200 chapters in 80 countries and works closely with the UN on mutual initiatives promoting globalization, again preparing for the antichrist.

In a recent speech the pope warned against a "virus of polarization," the turmoil in the world created by hostility between different nationalities, races, or beliefs. Comments like this also come from the pope's agenda to destabilize existing governments preparing for the rise of the antichrist to establish a one world government and religion.

This Jesuit pope is openly campaigning for the new world order: ecumenism, the blending of religions, and globalism, the elimination of nation states and establishment of a one-world government and a one-world economy. To achieve this, all "extremists"

must be eliminated, including those who reject a one-world



Bible and who dare to "proselytize" (soul winners).

Jesus said the night would come when we could not work for the kingdom. New laws in Russia, China, Egypt, and India are making soul winning more difficult. Shadows are also gathering in the Western World.


