


Is The Church Losing The Great Commission?

Any student of the Bible is aware of the central position of the Great Commission to the life of the Christian. Yet, a recent study done by Christian pollster, Barna, found that 51 percent of American church goers do not even recognize the term. Only 37 percent

can identify one of the Great Commission verses when presented with a list of scriptures.

When a command is repeated 5 times in the Bible, it seems that Jesus was serious about it. But people hold several different views on who this applies to. One says that this was spoken only to the apostles to get the church established. This violates the context of Matthew 28:19-20 which clearly

means a world-wide endeavor, bigger than the little band of apostles that He was speaking to. Mark 16:14-18 echoes this general application as well as Luke 24:44-49, John 20:19-23 and Acts 1:4-8.

Another view is that the Great Commission does not apply to every believer, only those who have a special gift of evangelism. Soul winning is just another individual gift bestowed on various church members, but not a commission for all believers.

Unfortunately, a change in the modern Bibles is not helpful. Where the King James version uses the terms "teach" and "preach," the instruction is changed to "make disciples."

Linguist David W. Daniels points out the considerable difference here. "Teach" and "preach" is a method of presenting the gospel to everyone who will listen. "Make disciples" is a much more involved procedure, beyond the ability and training of the average church member.

Granted, the modern definition of teaching and preaching also involves considerable training and expertise. But Jesus defined it differently in Acts 1:8 saying that they should be "witnesses," —telling their story of their relationship with Him.

Barna's discovery exposes a subtle deception that has crept into our churches, basically eliminating personal witnessing by the believers. Few believers bother to tell the story of their journey to salvation, thinking they must be able to conduct an elaborate discipleship effort which will take more time than they can give.

Seminaries and denominational leaders have neglected emphasizing the "witnessing," of our personal story. Instead, the preferred method is to take time to build a friendship before attempting to share the gospel. In today's harried world, this kind of opportunity is rare to non-existent.

Soul winners over the years have found

a simple way to obey the Great Commission. Even if they are unable to "preach" or even "teach," they know how to communicate the gospel, even to a stranger on a moment's notice. An engaging gospel tract, passing from one's hand to another in a few seconds, is a Great Commission event —mission accomplished!

If the new reader is a believer, they can reflect on the Lord's mercy to them and have a moment of rejoicing. If unbeliever, it is an invitation to eternal life, which if ignored, has ominous consequences at Judgment Day. But they cannot complain to their Creator that they were not warned.

Believer, when the price of a candy bar will buy a handful of gospel tracts, do we expect to stand guiltless before our loving Judge one day?

Trucking for Christ started in 2001 at a truck stop in Norfolk, Virginia. As a Christian and a driver, I saw how great the mission field was. Truckers are out on the road for weeks at a time and cannot get to a church with those big rigs.

As a driver, I found some truck stop chapels, but they were either not King James only, or not strong on soul winning. So, God led me to start a King James Bible-believing, soul-winning trucking ministry that would get truckers saved, convict of sin, and feed Christians who were hungry for the Word.

By God's grace, about 1,000 truckers have been saved since we started, thousands of Chick gospel tracts and hundreds of free King James Bibles have been given to truckers and others, and a lot of Christian counseling has been done.

When It's Not Safe To Die

The following is an excerpt from One Heartbeat Away by author Mark Cahill. His book is designed to help us think about the inevitable: our death. It is a great witnessing tool to promote discussion with anyone not sure of their eternal destiny.

I talked to a young man one day who mentioned that he had been injured and wound up on an emergency room operating table. He said his heart had stopped beating and as his soul rose out of his body, immediately the sense of an evil presence began to come over him and he could hear an evil, hissing laughter. He told me he was so glad to get back into his body and be alive. He now knows how real evil is.


A respiratory nurse who works in an emergency room told me about a patient who had gone "code red," —he flatlined. She and some other medical personnel rushed over with the defibrillator to try to bring him back to life. They applied the paddles and revived him. She said that he started screaming and shouting, "The heat! the heat!" Then his heart stopped again.

They brought him back to the second time. He shouted, "The flames, the flames!" They lost him again.

Four times the man flatlined and was brought back, each time shouting about the heat or the flames. After the last time, he died, and they couldn't bring him back. She said all the doctors and nurses just stood there for a few minutes and stared at the body. They all knew that man went to hell. He was screaming it to them before he even got out of here.

I have met several people (all in a non-drug and non-alcohol-induced state) who experienced a burning hell rather than being with Jesus, or the typical tunnel-and white-lights scenario. So, don't believe that sweetness-and-light near-death stories are the only kind people report.

Dr. Maurice Rawlings, a cardiologist, has witnessed numerous patients during and after their near-death experiences and reported his findings in Omni magazine. After interviewing 300 patients immediately after resuscitation, Dr. Rawlins says that nearly half of them reported seeing a lake of fire, devil-like figures, and other sights reflecting the reality of hell. "There is a life after death," Rawlins said, and if I don't know where I'm going, it's not safe to die.


Pseudo-Scientists Take Another Shot at Manhood

Another evidence today of the Apostle Paul's "science falsely so called" is a report about the American Psychological Association's new guidelines on counseling men. Looking everywhere but in the right place, they have decided that our "traditional masculinity" is harmful to the individual man and unhealthy to growing boys.

The character traits of stoicism, competitiveness, dominance and aggression are considered the source of violence, suicides, and other anti-social behavior — such as increased hostility toward LGBT men.

Leadership of the Association is laced with same-sex sympathizers. Thus, the report is heavily tilted in favor of gender confusion. Their concern seems to be more about "hostility toward LGBT men" than growing boys into mature manhood.

As Bible-believers, we can recognize that this is just another misguided recom-



mendation by the worshippers of pseudo-science.

Adopting a worldview based on evolution gets God out of the picture, leaving a vacuum to be filled with all kinds of evils.

The traits that the Association is deploring,


originate from the heart of man not yet regenerated by the Spirit of God. One proponent of the report exulted: "If we can change men, we can change the world." He is exactly right but his method of changing men ignores realities that God put in the Bible about mankind.

Jeremiah (17:9) observed that the heart

of man "...is deceitful above all things, and desperately wicked: who can know it?" The gospel presented in the New Tes-

tament includes a rebirth of the heart that is required for peace and love to dominate one's character.

Godless psychologists ignore the spiritual aspect of man's make up. All they have left then to



change man is outside influences, education being their primary tool. When Satan inspires someone's overactive masculinity to shoot up a school it's considered a mental health issue, not a spiritual one. This requires more government control of the education system and a better government surveillance of potential derangement.

No consideration is given to the basic depravity of the human heart and/or the possibility of demonic influence. In fact, when God is ruled out of the picture, the idea of evil involving a spiritual being is also eliminated. Evil is only the negative effect of bad genetic mutations or a hostile environment.

Christian Pollster Charts Confusion Over Evangelism

A recent survey by Barna pollsters finds that 47% of church-going young adults do not believe in evangelism. Barna also found that over half of them do not recognize the term "Great Commission." Soul winners, does this mean we are failing this next generation? I'm afraid so.

Modern education, based on the Theory of Evolution, has many young people confused. If they are only accidents in a godless cosmos, they are wondering, "What am I here for??"

We need to explain what God says about our purpose in life: to spread some "good news." According to Barna, it appears that even those who claim to have responded to the "good news" are not sharing it.

In fact, it also appears we are not impressing them with the need to share it. If we obey the Great Commission we faithfully share the "good news" of the gospel. That includes instructing people that they need to teach others. Jesus said: "...Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you;" Part of what He commanded was the commandment itself: "Go ye therefore, and teach all nations..." (See Matthew 28:18-20.)

Jesus left no loopholes. If we claim to be Christian, we are obligated to:

- 1. Share the good news (gospel) with unbelievers.
- 2. Teach others their responsibility to share the good news.

No Christian can be guiltless who does not take this seriously. We will be greatly embarrassed on Judgment Day when the fruit of our life is burned in the stubble pile. (See 1 Corinthians 3.)

So, in addition to teaching unbelievers about Christ's way, we are obligated to teach other believers, including the next generation, of their obligation to the Great Commission.

Barna makes it clear that evangelism is

more than just bringing someone to a decision to follow Jesus. "Following" means developing spiritual maturity. And along the way we must become "witnesses" of what Jesus has done in our lives.

And Barna also found that following this pattern fits well into the latest perspective of the unbeliever. They're not much impressed with logical arguments or even scripture "proof texts." They want to know what it has done for you.

Young people have grown up in mass confusion. They likely did not have much, if any, exposure to church or Bible. "Edu-




cation" was supposed to be the great savior. But there they learned that they are only "mutants" in an accidental cosmos. Only the "fittest" survive to enhance mankind's progress to nowhere. Satan has gutted life of its purpose.

Missionary Bruce Hunsaker sends his thanks for all your help providing tracts for the growing work there. He is leading street evangelism, now working with 14 local churches. He writes: "The churches who have a burden for public ministry say they are encouraged to go out because they have something to offer their people to help them. Truck Stop! Praise the Lord! It was a little before 11:00 p.m. when I handed him a gospel tract. By 1:22 a.m., he had gotten saved, and was asking one question after another, eagerly wanting to absorb as much Bible as he could.

I gave him a King James Bible and some Chick tracts: I have rarely seen any new convert with such a desire to know as much Bible as he had!

Another trucker, John, said he felt God leading him to get out of his truck and come into the truck stop. He came into the service and got saved. John said he had been brought up in a Christian home.







The "Failure" That Wasn't



I was ordering my usual "healthy" diet —fast food. As is my custom, after paying for my meal, I handed the clerk, a young woman in her twenties, a Chick tract. "Here, you'll enjoy the cartoon when you have your break."

The vast majority of the time, I get the same reaction. "Oh, thanks! I'll read this." Then the tract goes into a back pocket. Once in a while, a clerk will tell me, "We have a whole stack of these under the counter, so everyone gets to read them." But not this time.

She looked at the tract in my hand, then pulled her hand back, saying "No thanks."

Hmmm. That one doesn't happen often. But I was not the least discouraged. You see, one glance at the tract told her what it was. She knew full well what she was refusing.

I immediately understood several things:

- 1. She had read at least one of the other tracts I had left (Chick tracts get read!). She knew what was in it.
- 2. She had understood God's claims on her life and had said "No." She didn't want to be reminded again.
- 3. I had succeeded in doing what Jesus commanded me to do, to "preach" the Gospel. She had gotten the message —and made a personal decision.

I know that some day she will kick herself in anguish as she remembers her poor choice to reject Christ. But she will know that someone told her. She had her chance.

You see, everyone needs a chance. What they do with that chance is up to them. But Jesus made clear to me that I must give them that chance.

If they reject it, just like they rejected Him, that is the choice that the Lord allows them to make. A poor choice.

But He doesn't let me off the hook to witness just because I might not get the percent return on my tracts I would like. He said "preach!"

Chick Publications gets so many notes from people who had that chance but turned it down. Yet, God wasn't done with them. He kept after them, convicting them, reminding them of the tract, until they finally gave in to Jesus. Brothers and Sisters in Christ:

A brother in Christ asked an excellent question today. I have to share it with you.

"How come I didn't know God since I was a teenager? Why did I have to go through many bad things? I wish I knew God a way long time ago...."

I responded, "If people did not follow through and get the gospel to you, then you did not get it until someone was faithful. God often sends many people —but it doesn't mean they are going to carry the message."

I just posted a video on our YouTube channel about my conversion. It shows the very location where I was saved on June 7th, 1972. It shows how a guy that I only saw once in my life decided to walk from the alleyway into our apartment group and talk to me. He gave me a Chick tract (*This Was Your Life*) and stayed with me while I read it. Then he asked if I wanted to receive Jesus as my Saviour —I did!

Here's the thing. Nobody in my life got anywhere close to doing what that man did, despite my going to a Christian church off and on throughout my life, and to some religious meeting almost every Sunday from birth.

So, what happened with everyone else? Why didn't anyone else come to me with the gospel to save my soul?

That's where saved people like you and I come in.

We have a commission from God to preach, to teach, to spread the gospel. He never said we are responsible for the response. We are responsible to tell them and let them decide.

That's why we have Chick tracts. I love coming to the end of the day and discovering that I have to re-fill my pockets with tracts. I like realizing that I'm running out and may have to run and get more from one of my stashes (in the car, in the house, in the office). That means I'm getting the message out.

But I'll never stop being grateful for the day that man responded to God and reached me.

May we all take these opportunities, whether we see the result, or not. May your pockets always be running out of Chick tracts – for the right reasons.

"I Was Outraged!"

As a Catholic, I was never taught the Bible, nor was I encouraged to read it. So, I went to different priests with a basket full of questions.
