Gospel Tracts: A Long and Famous History

When Gutenberg perfected the printing press, it not only opened the flood gates for Bibles, but also gospel tracts. Most great champions of the gospel considered tracts as vital to their ministry.

John Wesley, the founder of the Methodist church, was a strong advocate of soul winning and spreading the gospel through various means, including the use of gospel tracts. In his journal, Wesley wrote about the effectiveness of gospel tracts and encouraged their distribution: "God does nothing but in answer to prayer, and even they who have been converted to God without hearing of a Bible, were converted by the instrumentality of a tract."

Wesley wrote and distributed many gospel tracts throughout his life. Some of his most famous tracts include "The Almost Christian," "Awake, Thou That Sleepest," and "A Call to Backsliders."

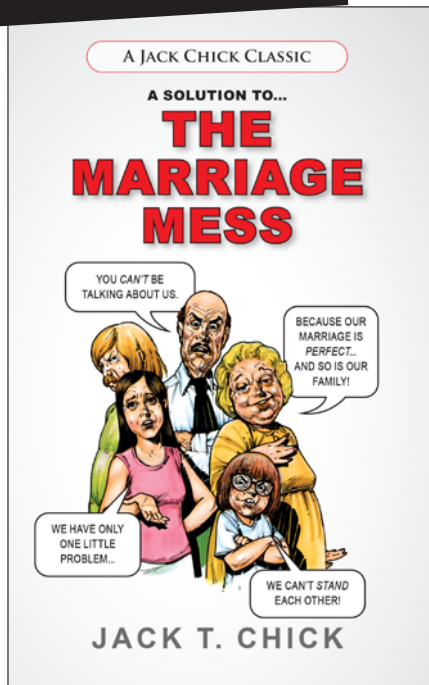
These tracts, along with many others, were instrumental in reaching people across England and beyond.

Charles Spurgeon, a famous Baptist preacher and evangelist in the 19th century, was a strong advocate for the use of gospel tracts. He once said, "Tracts are more useful than sermons, because most people will read a tract when they will not come to hear a sermon."

Spurgeon also saw the potential of tracts to reach beyond local communities and into different languages and cultures. He was known for his own extensive use of tracts, which he distributed widely both in his native England and in other countries. His advocacy helped to popularize their use in the 19th century and beyond. He said, "If you cannot preach a sermon, you can at least distribute a tract. This is an age of cheap and plentiful literature. Let us use the

“Diana Banister of Concerned Women for America is glad to see that parents are doing something about the ongoing effort to sexualize the nation’s youth,” says the American Family News (afn.net).

In today’s increasingly godless culture, parents become frontline soldiers in the war against Satan’s attack on our children.

Other families, who have buyer’s remorse over what their tax dollars buy in the public schools, are pushing legislators to free up those dollars for parents to choose where to spend them. The school choice concept has been around for some time, but several mechanisms are being used.

Some states are issuing vouchers to parents to spend at the school of their choice. Others are setting up Education Savings Accounts (ESAs), scholarship programs and tax credits. Even home schooling is included in some of the programs.

Again, it is the parents that are rising up and demanding relief from the government schools that have gravitated away from basic education into propaganda mills and purveyors of godlessness and perversity. One good result from the COVID-19 lockdowns is that it allowed the parents to look over the kids’ shoulders and discover this creeping evil.

Another victory came in Pennsylvania where two different school districts refused an application by The Satanic Temple to sponsor an After School Satan Club on campus. One school had initially agreed, but community pressure from parents and items in the local news media persuaded the superintendent against it.

The Satanic Temple had argued that they should be allowed if Child Evangelism Fellowship was permitted to main-

tain an after-hours Good News Club, training students, who chose to attend, in the Bible. Parents and the community are to be commended for alertness to this threat.

The same perverted sex education that has surfaced in the United States has also been found in Great Britain. Fortunately, a Christian member of parliament who is a mother of three has mounted a campaign against it, supported by fifty other conservative members of parliament. They have drafted a letter to the Prime Minister, Rishi Sunak, asking him to demand a review by the Department of Education.

The letter detailed how the children are “being taught about extreme and dangerous sex acts [and] encouraged to share intimate details about sexual desires with classmates and teachers.” Fortunately, the Prime Minister is responding.

The coalition in Parliament is also backed by an organization that has brought legal focus on the problem. The leader of that organization, called Let Kids be Kids, said that he was “appalled, absolutely appalled [that] some of the material that’s in there is quite frankly, outrageous.”

The rapid increase in the homosexual evil is almost breathtaking. Worldwide spiritual decadence has created a vacuum that Satan is more than happy to fill. Even the most recent development of transgenderism is showing up in multiple countries. Some countries in Africa are moving against it legally but much of the rest of the world is coming down on them for their “homophobia.”

But the good news is that Christians and decent people are rising up in righteous indignation. Satan never sleeps so it is necessary for us to never let our guard down against his devices. ■

Prisons: ‘A Mission Field Next Door’

There are many mission fields open to church members. One of the most convenient is local prisons. Central to a successful prison ministry is the chaplain in that prison.

For 50 years, Jo Anna Woody, Director of Mission Possible, has been backing these chaplains with Bibles and gospel literature. Chick tracts have played a large part in her ministry.

Here, she shares a story of one chaplain who took a long bus ride before a tract abruptly turned him around and pointed him toward his lifelong ministry:

I was raised in a Christian home but in my early teens, I became rebellious and wanted to see the “real” world. I decided after graduating from high school that New York City was the place I could “see the world.”

I left Texas on a big Greyhound bus bound for New York City (1990). I felt I’d be safe from a Christian witness there! As I passed through each state, I was a little disappointed to see from that bus window it wasn’t too different from where I just left!

But I was such a baby I didn’t know much of anything. I had a little children’s Bible that I would read every single night and I would make up my own little devotions not knowing what devotions were. But I wanted that personal relationship.

But I didn’t know what it was supposed to be like. Anyway, my mom’s friend came to Christ, just radically changed from dark to light and we saw the change in her. And she was telling us that we needed to come to her church because they really preached the Bible.

I didn’t really know the difference, so we finally went. That’s when I heard the

On stops along the way, I would go into the bus stations and walk around, searching for what the “world” looked like. After several stops, we arrived at the Greyhound Bus Station on Eighth Avenue in New York City.

I was the typical tourist —eyes about to pop out! The station was huge, people milling about, and I was lost (in more ways than one) as I joined the crowd headed for the street. Just before I left that huge building, a young man, a little younger than I, approached me with a big smile and something in his hand.

I had made eye contact, so it was too late to turn my glance! He welcomed me to New York with a broad grin and asked if he could give me a Christian booklet. I breathed a long breath, grateful that he didn’t try to engage me in a conversation. I took the booklet and started walking away.

I saw a bench, sat down to get my bearings for this new adventure and opened the booklet. It was in comic form, and the title got my attention —THIS

I have loved and distributed Chick Tracts since the 1970's. The Lord has blessed me with being able to put tens of thousands into circulation. press for spreading the gospel and let us do it with all our might.”

In a sermon he preached in 1873, Spurgeon said: “Tracts are one of the most useful forms of literature, and we ought to use them continually. They scatter the good seed far and wide; they bring truth home to men’s business and bosoms, and thus they work wonders.”

Jonathan Edwards, another prominent figure of the Great Awakening, also recognized the value of gospel tracts. In his writing he encouraged the use of tracts to reach those unable or unwilling to attend church or hear sermons in person.

Edwards saw gospel tracts as a way to supplement and reinforce the spoken word, writing in one of his sermons, “Preaching is the appointed means of salvation, but...other means must be used as well.” He believed that tracts could provide a written record of the gospel message that people could revisit and reflect on in their own time.

Edwards also saw the potential of tracts to reach beyond the local communities, writing, “By means of... printed discourses, not only many in

the neighborhood, but others in distant places, may be instructed and warned.”

Gospel tracts were an important tool used during the **Great Awakening**, a period of revival that took place in the 18th century in the American colonies and Great Britain. During this time, preachers such as George Whitefield, Jonathan Edwards, and John Wesley used gospel tracts as a particularly effective tool because they were inexpensive to produce and easy to distribute.

They could be printed in large quantities and distributed widely, making it possible to reach large numbers of people.

Today, we find that printed tracts do a unique job in our digital world. They can provide an unequaled durability and persistence.

We have stories of a tract that sat for years in a desk drawer patiently waiting for someone to be ready for its message. Another survived a mud puddle in the street and still delivered a destiny-changing message.

Today, the word is that gospel tracts don’t work. But history proves otherwise. And —so does the Chick testimony file. ■

Even Women Inmates Are Not Safe from Transgenders

The new social contagion of transgenderism is now affecting people who have no place to hide: California women prisoners. As of February 26, 2023, 349 biological male inmates have requested transfer to female institutions. 47 have been approved, 21 denied and 35 changed their minds. The others are still under review.

This process began with the passage in California of the Transgender Respect, Agency and Dignity Act (SB-132) in 2021. Amanda Stulman, director of the advocacy organization Keep Prisons Single Sex, said

that she was “horrified that the transfer of criminal men into women’s prisons in California has continued.”

She said that 33% of the men claiming female gender and trying to transfer were registered sex offenders. Twenty-five percent had been convicted of a sex offense, higher than the general prison population.

Stulman says that “There have been allegations of pregnancies and sexual assaults, of the introduction of condoms and other birth control, and information

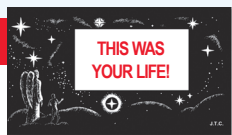

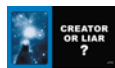

about options in the event of pregnancy.” In April, a biological male transgender was sentenced to seven years in prison for raping a female inmate in Rikers Island, New York.

And this is not just a U.S. problem. In the U.K., male transgender convicts have made seven sexual assaults on women inmates. In Canada a convicted male sex offender, guilty of raping a 13-year-old girl, has been transferred to a women’s prison in Ontario because he “identified” as “trans.” This is only one example of such transfers.

The devil is very busy trying to destroy

womanhood. Drag Queens start early, grooming little girls as sex objects. Up to 20% of teenage girls are convinced they are in the wrong body and need mutilating changes. Transgender athletes are eliminating the competition in women’s sports.

Finding a worthy husband is getting increasingly difficult, as men “leave the natural use of the woman” and burn in lust for one another. (See Romans 1:27.)

Widespread sexual perversion is usually the last straw that brings God’s judgment on a culture.

MEXICO and GUATEMALA

ONE MILLION Chick tracts are on their way to Oaxaca, Mexico, thanks to your giving. Many of them will also go on to Guatemala.

Missionary Joe Hendrigson writes: "In Mexico, tracts will be distributed throughout Oaxaca, Chiapas, Guerrero, and Vera Cruz. We are being blessed with a million tracts but they will go quickly. Mexico is on fire with the Gospel, and with your help we will add fuel to the evangelistic efforts of local churches. The need is great, the soldiers of God are ready to evangelize, the only thing that is lacking is the ammunition.

"We continue to receive calls on a daily basis for tracts and evangelism material. On a recent call from Guatemala, we

were begged to supply tracts. The pastor who called is going to drive from the capital to the border of Mexico to meet us and assist in bringing the tracts into the country. They will then be taken to be distributed among many missionaries and pastors in Guatemala. We recently sent some Bibles and gospel literature to Guatemala, and this has only scratched the surface of what God is doing and wanting to do in this country. The cost to mail this material was very high so personally taking them in to Guatemala is the best way to get material into the country."

Missionary Tim Urling wrote about the 80,000 Chick tracts you provided for big outreaches in Mexico. He writes: "We held different Gospel tract campaigns and open-air meetings which have resulted in hundreds of people hearing the gospel and well over 100 professions of faith. The churches we've helped to establish continue to win souls, preach the gospel, see people saved, baptized, and added to the church. They support various missionaries as well."

is being raised who knows not God.” Lake has a burden to “establish sound Bible believing churches” throughout the province. They have asked the Chick Mission Fund to provide those 500,000 tracts.

BAHAMAS

After serving as a missionary in Ethiopia for twelve years, Joshua Fussner saw a new opportunity in Bahamas. His pastor describes this veteran missionary as a “go-getter.”, who is currently getting to minister to hundreds of youth and has a lot of liberty with tracts and preaching the gospel. Fussner is organizing an outreach to knock on every door in Freeport, the second largest city in this country. He will eventually need 50,000 tracts, but has limited storage, so the Mission Fund has sent him the first 10,000 so he can begin.

GUATEMALA

Although they had to be shipped by a circuitous method, the 10,000 tracts for Missionary Carlos Donate have finally arrived! Getting tracts into this country has been difficult, but the Lord gave us a way. Donate is committed to tract ministry, and will use the tracts well.

IVORY COAST

New missionaries Nathan and Hannah Schrock are soon headed to French-speaking Ivory Coast of West Africa. The container that holds

their goods will also be stocked with 25,000 French Chick tracts. Schrock explains “we plan to focus on the villages, teaching the Ivorian people the truth of God’s Word with the goal of seeing indigenous local churches planted where people are saved and disciplined.” Thank you for giving to provide them with the best church planting tools we could send: Chick tracts.

KENYA

Missionary Joetta Smith is a brave lady who answered God’s call and moved to Kenya, where she has been teaching the Bible to local pastors and training them to get into the streets with the Gospel. INDIA

We all saw the horrible images during COVID of the death and suffering in India. Evangelism nearly stopped, as the lockdown shut everyone in. But now, things are opening up, and missionaries like Kathy Smith are taking advantage of it. At the time of this writing, your giving is providing the printing of 110,000 Chick tracts in the languages of Kannada, Telugu, Tamil, Oriya and Hindi for the churches that work with Smith. Persecution here is intense, and evangelism is dangerous, but they will not be stopped. They know that the time is short.

BURMA

Missionary Josh McBryar is taking 11,000 Burmese and Thai tracts to Thailand to witness along the Burma border. The terrible violence in Burma has produced thousands of refugees who have lost everything, and need Jesus. Thank you for providing these tracts.

KOREA

Joshua Yun continues to shuttle back and forth between the churches he has planted in Korea and the Philippines. You provide monthly shipments of tracts to support new church plants. He explains, "My mission is to plant churches in Korea, and at the same time to evangelize

other Asian nationals who are in Korea, and train and send them to their own countries as missionaries, and go with them to plant churches in the countries. This is the reason why the new church and I are located in Young-San where most of the foreign people live and the majority of foreign embassies are in Korea."

MAURITIUS

James and Cindy Herringson, missionaries sent by Metropolitan Baptist Church in Australia, have received a shipment of French Chick tracts for this largely Hindu nation off the southern coast of Africa. The culture makes evangelism difficult here, but Jesus said "Go!"

PHILIPPINES

At the time of this writing, the second Philippine Chick tracts, just arrived in Manila. A non-profit there

But that's not all that's happening. Missionary Bruce Hunsaker has

a group of pastors that he has taught to take teams from their churches to the streets, in ongoing outreach. Each group goes through about 10,000 tracts a month. Imagine the impact! We are now preparing another shipment of an additional 320,000 tracts to feed these dedicated teams. ■

- 12 *There is a generation that are pure in their own eyes, and yet is not washed from their filthiness.*
- 13 *There is a generation, O how lofty are their eyes! and their eyelids are lifted up.*
- 14 *There is a generation, whose teeth are as swords, and their jaw teeth as knives, to devour the poor from off the earth, and the needy from among men.”* (Proverbs 30:11-14)

Can this be turned around? Yes! Brothers and Sisters, it is **the perfect moment** to share the gospel.

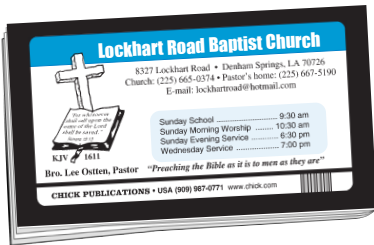
